Recent Favorable Decisions

Little v. Hartz Hotel Servs., Inc., 199 N.Y.S3d 841 (N.Y. Cty. Sup. Ct., Oct. 11, 2023) (obtained partial dismissal of tip credit claims and a ruling that appropriate damages for tip retention by managers is disgorgement of the tips, not invalidation of the tip credit).
